



## HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### 1. What do I do if I want to participate in the Health Information Exchange (HIE)?

You don't have to do anything. You are automatically opted in.

### 2. What information is available to other practices on the HIE?

The Following items will be available for import during the initial phase

1. Medications
2. Allergies
3. Diagnoses entered in NextGen by other practices
4. Chart Notes
5. Lab orders and results from other NextGen practices

### 3. What if I do not want my information shared with other practices?

You should fill out our Opt Out form and your information will not be shared electronically. If you are referred to a provider with in the HIE, it will be sent to a provider by mail or fax for continuity of care.

### 4. Can anyone view my information without my consent?

Only those involved with your treatment will be able to view your information. Please review the HIPPA policy related to your privacy for more information.

### 5. What if I change my mind and want to participate in the HIE at a later time?

You can opt back in after opting out by signing a new form. The receptionist can help you with this process. Your information from that point forward will be available on the HIE.
